


Say hello to: Reinhard Kromer-von Baerle

CLOUD SEEDING brings on the rain

Prevention of natural disasters through targeted weather modification

The number of extreme weather events is increasing worldwide. Prolonged heavy rainfall harbours risks just as much as hailstorms or dry spells.

With this in mind, FTI Engineering Network GmbH is working on an innovative project together with its new colleagues from APUS at the Strausberg site: cloud seeding.

FUNCTIONALITY AND OBJECTIVES

The aim is to specifically influence existing weather conditions, in order to prevent natural disasters. During the first phase of the project, specially configured aircraft equipped with modern measurement and release systems will be used. They make it possible to precisely analyse clouds and make them rain at specific locations. The aim is not to create new clouds, but to control existing weather systems in such a way that extreme events are mitigated.

"Cloud seeding can render a decisive contribution to disaster prevention," explains project manager, Tim Schürmann. "By measuring weather fronts at an early stage and taking targeted action, we can significantly reduce risks for agriculture, transport and urban areas."

FROM DEVELOPMENT TO CERTIFICATION

Engineering teams develop all the necessary modifications to the aircraft, document everything and transfer it to a Supplemental Type Certificate (STC). This ensures that the systems are not only technically innovative, but also aviation-certified and ready for use.

MORE THAN JUST DISASTER CONTROL

The technology also opens up a host of new perspectives for sustainable water management. Regions that regularly suffer from drought could benefit specifically from precipitation in future. Cloud seeding, therefore, not only offers protection

against flooding, but also potential for dealing with the consequences of climate change.

A LOOK INTO THE FUTURE

The project team is convinced that this solution will be used far beyond pilot projects. Going forward, series production could be set up to meet the growing demand for effective and responsibly used weather modification systems.

Measuring systems for research helicopters

FTI supports DLR with modernisation efforts

The five-seater BO 105 multipurpose helicopter is considered an aviation classic. The German Aerospace Centre (DLR) has been using the highly modified model as a research platform for several years. FTI Engineering Network GmbH is developing a new base and rotor measuring system so that the machine can continue to be used reliably for scientific missions in future. It covers everything from design and integration to aeronautical certification (standard test conditions).

"DLR previously used a rotor measurement system that was more than ten years old, which is now being replaced entirely," explains project manager, Thorsten Otto. Furthermore, a new floor plate has been installed in the cargo hold, which allows the flexible installation

of different measuring devices. A modified rack (housing) with an integrated, uninterruptible power supply, which accommodates the DLR's existing components, was created for data acquisition.

INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY FOR RELIABLE RESULTS

One particular focus is on the rotor measuring system. Whereas in the previous version, power and data were still transmitted via a classic connecting element - a slip ring -FTI now relies on modern radio transmission.

Only for the power supply is a special, additional component still used, which was developed together with the company, Rie-Tech. This solution retains all the flight capabilities of the BO 105, such as the ability to land safely even at an angle.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

The new floor panel in the cargo hold and the measuring rack have already been installed. The functional and electromagnetic compatibility tests have been successfully completed. The rotor measurement system now needs to be finalised and tested in flight trials, together with DLR pilots, in order to evaluate possible effects on the aircraft.

CONTRIBUTION TO AVIATION RESEARCH

With this project, FTI is emphasising the value of BO 105 as a unique research platform. The modifications that have been designed and certified ensure their future viability and, at the same time, make an important contribution to aviation research and the development of new technologies that will be used in civil and military aviation later on
